We further confirm that as from the date of 14 February, 2021, all dividends that have not been collected by the relevant beneficiaries shall be transferred to the Securities and Commodities Authority, which shall be responsible for the disbursement of the value of the dividends to the relevant beneficiaries amongst the shareholders upon claim, being made in regard of the same
